Tournament Rules

Start Times: The listed starting times are for guidance only. An event will not start prior to the time listed, but competitors should be at the venue a half hour before scheduled playing time. DO NOT BE LATE, OR YOU MAY FACE DEFAULT.

Rules: International Table Tennis Federation rules shall govern all play. The tournament committee reserves the right to cancel any event with insufficient entries.

Membership Eligibility: All competitors must be registered members of TTSASK.

EQUIPMENT: TTSASK Approved Tables and DHS D40+ White Plastic Three-Star Balls.

Prizes: Medals for the winner and runners-up in all events. Gift Cards through Draws.

Doors will be open at 5pm on Friday and 8am on Saturday.

Scoring: All round robin matches are best of 3 and all finals are best of 5, with all games to 11 points.

EVENT LIMITATIONS

Players may only enter one event per start time

Ratings: Ratings from TTCAN website (www.ttcan.ca) of the most recent period will be used.

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

Singles Events: First stage in each event will be a round robin, then each player will be divided into A and B divisions leading to single knockout **Tournament referee reserves the right to alter the structure of any events.**

1 Star Tournament

The tournament committee reserves the right to cancel or modify competition format of any event with insufficient entries.

Start Times: The listed starting times are for guidance only. **DO NOT BE LATE, OR YOU MAY FACE DEFAULT. If all participants are available and agree, the event will start earlier than scheduled.**

Clothing/Shoes: Shirts, shorts or skirts, of <u>colors different than the ball</u> and non-marking runners.

High School - must be in grade 9 to 12 from the same school for high school points to count. Elementary Junior High - must be in grade 1 to 8 from the same school for school points to count. Doubles events will include, Boy's, Girl's and Mixed

Singles Format

High School Division: Senior Event - Grade 11 & 12 Junior Event-Grade 9 & 10 **Elementary/Junior High Division:** Junior Event - Grade 7 & 8 Elementary Event-Grade 5 & 6 Elementary Event - Grade 1 - 4

Doubles Event

Doubles events will include, Boy's, Girl's and Mixed High School Division - Grade 9-12 Junior Division - Grade 7 & 8 Junior- Grade 5 & 6 Elementary- Grade 1-4

Singles Format

Start time 5:00pm Fri Mar 31

All players can compete in the singles event and one (1) doubles event.

Five (5) players or less - event will be a round robin event final with all players playing against each other.

Six (6) or more players;

Stage 1- preliminary round robin groups with players advancing to either the A event or B event.

Stage 2 - A & B will be knock-out.

Point Allocations as follows;

Five (5) players or less; 20 points will be allocated to the top finisher and points will descend by 4 points per placing.

Six (6) or more players; 20 points will be allocated for the A - event with the top finisher receiving 20 point in each event and points will descend by 4 point per placing to a maximum of 8th place. In the B Event, first place will receive 10 points and points will descend by one point to a maximum of 8th place.

DOUBLES FORMAT

Start Time 5:00pm Mar 31

The Doubles portion will include the following events: Boy's, Girl's and Mixed

Athletes may play in the singles event and <u>one (1)</u> doubles event.

Five (5) Teams or less - Round Robin Final (Event will be a final).

Events with 5 Teams or less will only be allocated one set of points starting at 40 points.

Six (6) Teams or more - Preliminary round robin and then divided in A and B Event.

Number of teams advancing to the A division will be at the referee's discretion. The remaining teams will advance to the B Division.

Stage 1- preliminary round robin groups with players advancing to either the A event or B event.

Stage 2 - A & B are knock-out at the discretion of the referee.
